


Figure 4. Modification complete. Note the upside-down socket in the U2 position.

After mounting the upside-down into the socket of U2 using the leftover component leads, bend wires from the socket to the appropriate solder lugs on the rear of the DB25 and solder appropriately. Figure 4 shows a detail of the completed result.
